HISTORY

The establishment of Lideta Catholic Cathedral School (LCCS), formerly known as Nativity Boys' School, was started in 1953 by the Catholic Archdiocese of Addis Ababa. From 1956-1973, the De La Salle Brothers, or the Christian Schools, took over the school administration. It was then handed over to the administration of the Archdiocese of Addis Ababa. In the first year, there were only 50 students in a single classroom. Later, the school expanded to accommodate more students. As a result, the enrolment capacity has increased. The school was upgraded from Elementary and Junior School to High School in 1994.

Promoting Integral Human Formation

CULTURE

LCCS is infamous among high schools. This is because we have one of the most **intensive** curriculums in the country.

RIGOR

LCCS has a handcrafted curriculum by each teacher beyond the mandated courses. New students struggle to adapt to the intensive study times they have to dedicate. We encourage all of our students to be collaborative with each other.

LCCS is not just academic. We also have a rich local culture. This came to be through the unique environment LCCS offers students. And one of the things everyone knows LCCS for is... **basketball**.

BASKETBALL

LCCS has not only sculpted generations of academic wonders, but we have also helped students find their passion for basketball and hone their skills to the fullest under the strict supervision of our coach, Daniel. Many players in our A team have gone on to play in professional basketball, some making it their life's careers. Any student of LCCS knows that Friday lunchtime is dedicated to basketball. Every Friday, a match is held. It could be between Grade 12's A team and Grade 11's A team, or between LCCS's A team and B team, or it could be against another school's team, or even against LCCS Alumni! Whatever opponent it was, the LCCS community never missed the game.

ADMISSIONS

Students can apply to LCCS only when entering Grades 1, 7, 9, or 11. However, students with siblings currently in the school can apply for any grade. Parents should bring all the necessary documents – namely their previous school transcripts, report cards showing that the student has been promoted, the registration fee, and birth certificates – and register their children. They will have to take an entrance examination to decide whether the students will be able to enroll or not. Our school is **very selective** with an average admission rate of **34.6%**.

CLASS RANK

LCCS believes in growth through friendly competition, and hence, we rank our students to motivate them to do better than their classmates or to strive to keep their position at the top of their class. But, we don't believe class rank should dictate their futures, so we don't use these rankings beyond domestic purposes, and class ranks aren't documented in any way.

GPA SCALING

Our students are evaluated using a 100-point scale, as is the standard for all high schools in Ethiopia. However, we use the 4.0 GPA scale for unweighted GPA and the 5.0 GPA scale for weighted GPA when recording our students' results. We also use the letter scale for easier GPA projection. Our scaling is as follows:

A+ = 100- 95% A = 94 - 80% B+ = 79 -65% B = 64 - 60% C+ = 59 - 55% C = 54 - 50% D = 49 - 40% F = Below 40% UNWEIGHTED


